Our 4th Exchanged Life Conference of this year was held in July, at the retreat of the **Living Word Fellowship** in Parádördő, a mountain resort-center in a beautiful valley in North-Hungary,. There were about 30 attendants with very open and receptive heart (actually they were the audience most enjoying my jokes yet). One of the elders reacted: „It is hard for me to explain briefly what a blessing your teachings gave us in the retreat. If I wanted to put it into one word I would say: 'revolutionary'. Another remark of an old missionary friend: „A well balanced teaching about grace at last! I can fully accept it.
