

Dear Friends,

Let me inform you of the thrilling news around Grace Ministries Budapest and my family.

We performed our 5th and 6th Exchanged Life conference of this year. It is three times more than last year, mainly thanks to the activity of our Team. If we end the rather complicated legal process we will have a new, fully Hungarian Board that consists of these Team members, who are already very active participants of the work. **The 5th conference was in our office in September 25-27** with 12 zealous participants; three of them already joined our new Internship, too. It seems to be a good idea to have conferences in our office besides the invitations to churches. We already scheduled the next office conference for Jan. 15-17.

The 6th conference was revolutionary for several reasons. To talk big I could say: we thought of beginning our international outreach activity with a conference **in Oxford, England...** Seriously, that was exactly the place! There is a group of Hungarian Christians living in England who meet regularly, and they hired a retreat-place there. The speaker invited for the conference was Laszlo Beregi. The other revolutionary thing was his first occasion to teach a whole conference (he already gave several parts before), and he performed very successfully.

Laszlo Beregi is also very active in the **Modular Internship, which we started in October** with 7 participants. We meet Monday evenings. Laszlo was teaching Romans 5-8 for several weeks, which was a great help to me, as I had a lot to do organizing our Taste of Grace concert. There are experimental changes on this course to make it more effective.

October 25 we performed the production we called **“The Taste of Grace concert-theater”**. The success was far beyond our expectation! Even the previously shown interest was surprising: almost all the tickets were sold two weeks before time. I needed to do then painful efforts to get back tickets from uncertain agents for persons who were interested, but a lot of people still couldn't get one. A lot of other testimonies reinforce that God himself provided us



a presentation of His Grace. The whole glory belongs to Him! All participants and guests received an extraordinary experience. I share **more about it in another attachment**.

Since I started to write my newsletter another great thing happened: we celebrated **the engagement of my second son, Máté**. Her fiancée, Arianna Dégi is a cute lady, medical student. She came to the Lord at the beginning of their relationship, was baptized, and together with Máté they are now very active in the Church youth. When you meet them, the love they show to each other is almost physically inflammable. We were 20 of us in our home together with Arianna's relatives, enjoying a great time and all kinds of excellent food.
